Shopping

The village of Limone has a variety of shops. I suggest that if you wish to take your group down to the village for the children to buy presents and souvenirs that you go straight after skiing one afternoon.

Shops are open until 7:30pm except on Wednesdays (half day closing).

Ski Hire

A list of all names for each school is kept at the ski hire shop with the numbers of the boots and the skis for each pupil. I advise that you carry a copy with you at all times in case of confusion between pupils.

If at any time during the week you wish to change your boots or skis please just go to the shop where you hired the equipment and they will help you.

Remember that if you change your boots you will also need to have your ski bindings adjusted.

Ski Return

On the last skiing day a time will be set for your group to return skis, boots, poles and helmets. Please clip all boots up before handing them in. Names will be crossed off the hire list at the shop as equipment is returned.

Injuries

In the unfortunate event of an accident the injured person will be taken off the mountain by the Mountain Rescue Patrol and the injury assessed. If necessary an ambulance will be called and the patient will be taken to Cuneo Hospital for treatment.

It is essential that a member of staff accompanies the injured person to the hospital. I suggest that one of your staff always skis around the nursery area during your school's lesson time as injured people are always brought to this area for treatment and assessment. This will avoid delay in locating the accompanying member of staff.

The relevant E111 form must be taken with you to avoid charges so it is essential that all staff know where the forms are kept.

Take enough money (aprox EUR. 50.00) for a taxi to return to the resort.
